*****If your water service is disconnected, your trash roll cart will be picked up.





2024 ELECTION November 5

Early Voting, etc.

VOTE

Early voting for the 2024 November General Election will be October 21 - November 2, Monday-Saturday from 8:30 am-6 pm at Lamar Library, 103 E. Main St. No Sunday voting.

If you wish to vote and will be unable to do so on election day, or during early voting, then you need to request an absentee by-mail ballot as soon as possible by coming to our office or calling. We are now taking requests for the November General Election. The address at Darlington County Voter Registration and Elections is 131 Cashua Street and telephone is 843-398-4900.

You must be registered at least 30 days prior to any election in order to vote in that election. Registration by mail applications must be postmarked at least 30 days prior to that particular election to be eligible. For the 2024 General Election: the in-person deadline is 5 pm on October 4, the online deadline is 11:59 pm on October 6, and by mail deadline is October 7.
