2-1 ESTABLISHMENT OF DISTRICTS
For the purpose of these regulations, the
Town of Lamar is hereby divided into the
following districts

AR Agricultural Reserve

R-1 Low Density Residential

R-2 Medium Density Residential

R-3 High Density Residential

CC Core Commercial

OC Office Commercial

GC General Commercial

LI Limited Industrial

Can you decide which zone or district you live in? You know for sure it is either R-1, R-2, or R-3.

A residential zone cannot accommodate a business, but a business district cannot accommodate a residence, either. Any unauthorized change of whatever kind by any person or persons shall be considered a violation of this ordinance and punished as provided by law.
