

ORDINANCES

Lamar is governed by a set of ordinances that are in compliance with county and state ordinances. Most of these ordinances have been in place for many years. They provide a legal and systematic way to handle a variety of issues. Reference Code of Ordinances in Town Hall when questioning a situation.

<u>Code of Ordinances</u> -page 69 Article III. Garbage and Refuse Removal and Disposal

10.305 Responsibility to Place Garbage. . .

Each occupant/user shall place his garbage for collection at the proper time in the proper manner near the sidewalk or highway in front of residence.

10.306 Cleaning of Containers
It shall be the
responsibility of the
occupant/user to keep their
individual container reasonably

10.307 Storage Area to Be Kept
Clean of Litter
It shall be the
responsibility of the
occupant/user to keep the pickup
point free of litter. . . . Containers
shall not be filled to overflow
capacity in order to prevent litter
distribution when emptying the
container.

Lamar has a new project to begin the new year. As reported in the December MONTHLY CONNECTION, the Town will begin the construction of a new Railroad Avenue Pump Station and Gravity Sewer Project.

The project includes the abandonment and demolition of an existing pump station and wetwell, which are in serious need of being replaced. The new construction will consist of a duplex package suction lift station on adjacent property.

This project is being funded in part with the South Carolina Infrastructure Investment Program (SCIIP), which is administered by the South Carolina Infrastructure Authority (RIA) and funded by Federal, State, and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds through the American Rescue Plan Act.

The Town's Water Loss is a constant concern. Please report any water you see in a place where water is not usually there. We must conquer this water loss. We cannot continue to pay for water not used.

The Town would like to thank the Christmas on Main Committee for beautifying the Town for Christmas. This committee worked many hours to make our Town a Christmas reality. The new addition of the Manger Scene was heartwarming—THE REASON FOR THE SEASON.
